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## **1) Introduction**

This is a continuing course of CHIN101. This course will teach students more language patterns and vocabularies for daily application. Those language patterns will enhance students' ability to utilize vocabularies to develop expression in different scenario. By the end of the course students will be able to carry out a conversation on daily-life topics as order food and beverages, discuss prices and quantities, describe different food taste, make expression about season and weather, make comparison, identify and discuss appearance, negotiate and bargain and express opinions, preferences, advise.

- Review and practice the learned language from CHIN101
- Guide students to use a language pattern in different context with learned vocabularies
- Enable students to start developing intermediate communication skills
